

SHIRLEY SEA ANGLING CLUB - SOUTHAMPTON

INFORMATION SHEET

Welcome to Shirley Sea Angling Club. We are a family friendly sea fishing club based in Southampton, Hampshire and have been running since 1962. We run competitions throughout the year for both seniors and juniors to which there is a small signing on fee (payable on the day) for each competition. Winners and runners-up receive prizes in cash/vouchers to spend in local tackle shops. Our competitions are made up from the following categories.

* Shore Fishing – Mainly Beaches

- * Shallow Boats Members who own their own boat (Starting Point Under Itchen Bridge)
- * Deep Boats Chartered Boats

We fish within the Angling Trust Wessex Regional Boundaries - Hayling Island in the East – West Bay in the West, (including the Isle of Wight) and fished to the Angling Trust rules and minimum size limits. *Note: - Fishing within the Southampton Docks is prohibited.*

Competitions are decided upon a pointing system, with 25 points given to the top weight, 24 to the second top weight, 23 to the third and so on down to 2 points, with 1 point given to those who fish but don't catch.
